The wheel of fortune is probably one of the oldest games of chance in the world.

On the wheel are 54 equally paced sections containing United States currency or symbols: twenty-three sections containing \$1 bills, fifteen sections containing \$2 bills, eight sections containing \$5 bills, four sections containing \$10 bills, two sections containing \$20 bills, and one section with a joker and one section with the Meadows Logo.

Big six allows you to bet on one or more numbers or symbols appearing on the gaming table layout. The betting layout offers you two identical areas on which you can place your bet. Each area displays various denominations of United States currency or symbols: \$1, \$2 Bills, \$5, \$10, \$20, a joker and Meadows logo. Bets may be placed directly on top of the chosen number or symbol until the dealer announces "no more bets." Winning bets are decided by the dealer spinning a wheel with a flapper at the top which marks the winning number or symbol when the wheel comes to rest. If the flapper comes to rest between two numbers or symbols the spin is void and the dealer will re-spin.

The odds are located under each bill or symbol.
